ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

Criteria

- Submissions from occupational health nurses, physician assistants or physicians, including those in residency training, industrial hygienists and other OEM professionals are welcome.
- Posters may focus on research results, case reports, educational projects or professional development. Posters
 may address any topic relevant to Occupational and Environmental Medicine. Submissions should ideally
 represent recent work.

- Author(s) may submit more than one abstract for review.
- If accepted, the author(s) or designate must register for at least one conference day and be present for the poster session on Thursday, November 30th from 5:00 to 8:00 pm.
- Posters must be free of any commercial interest. The ACCME defines a "commercial interest" as any proprietary entity producing health care goods or services, with the exemption of non-profit or government organizations and non-health care related companies.

Format

- Posters should fit an area that is no more than 4 feet high by 8 feet wide. Posters can be hung in the downstairs ballroom any time after noon on Thursday in preparation for the President's Reception which will be held in the same space. Posters should be taken down immediately after the reception. The Marriott Hotel staff will assist with hanging posters.
- If you prefer not to print your poster it can be displayed electronically. The cost is \$95 per poster. We would need a minimum of 5 electronic posters to be able to provide this service.
