The American Board of Preventive Medicine ([ABPM](#)) will provide information for those who are ABPM-certified about the transition from its Maintenance of Certification (MOC) program to its innovative new Continuing Certification Program (CCP). The webinar will outline the transitional requirements for maintaining ABPM certification for calendar years 2020, 2021, and 2022 as well as discussing the specifics of the 2023 rollout of the CCP, including a shift from the every 10-year, secure, high-stakes MOC exam to a longitudinal assessment methodology.

2. Detail the CCP requirements which begin in 2023 and impact Board certification, and
